This person will train staff in Environmental monitoring and surveillance activities, and will assist in developing monitoring and sampling plans and activities. Will also assist in water quality implementation. This person will also serve as the Departments QA/QC Manager.

Must have working knowledge of Federal and State Environmental regulations as they apply to grant and environmental management.

Will review and comment on all environmental documents including environmental assessments (EA's), environmental impact statements (EIS's), and Proposed Actions received by the Pueblo.
