**INTERESTED POTENTIAL ELECTION COMMISSION MEMBER**  
**December 2024**

Election Commission Member Interest

The Pueblo de San Ildefonso Election Commission is seeking nominees for one Governor appointed Member.

Goals, responsibilities, and requirements of the Election Commission are attached. If you are interested in becoming a Member, please submit a Letter of Interest and a resume by the end of day on Monday, January 10, 2025.

## SECTION 2. ELECTION COMMISSION

- (a) There shall be an Election Commission comprised of five Commissioners with three Commissioners elected by the people, one Commissioner selected by the Governor, and one Commissioner selected by the Council. The term of office for Election Commissioners shall be four years. Whenever a term expires for the seat of an appointed Commissioner, the Governor or the Council shall appoint a Commissioner within fifteen days after being sworn into office. Election Commissioners shall not be eligible to be a candidate for Governor or Council Representative.
- (b) Within twenty days of the adoption of this Agreement, the Council and the Governor shall select five Members to serve as Election Commissioners to conduct the First Election.
- (c) The Election Commission shall conduct criminal background checks on all candidates and the results shall be made available to any Member of the Pueblo.
- (d) The Election Commission shall be paid a fair compensation as established by the Council by law.

## SECTION 3. ELECTIONS.

- (a) General Elections shall be held on the first day of December of every year.
- (b) All elections shall be conducted by the Election Commission in a fair and impartial manner.
- (c) One person serving as an official in one elected or appointed governmental capacity cannot also serve as an official in another elected or appointed governmental capacity.

## SECTION 4. REMOVAL AND RECALL

### Recall

The people reserve the power to subject any member of the Council or the Governor to a recall election, and the Election Commission shall hold a Recall Election upon a petition signed by at least fifty percent (50%) of the eligible voters. A simple majority of the votes cast shall decide the outcome of the Recall Election. No more than two Members of the Council can be subjected to a Recall Process at one time, and any resulting vacancy shall be filled before any subsequent Recall Election can be held.

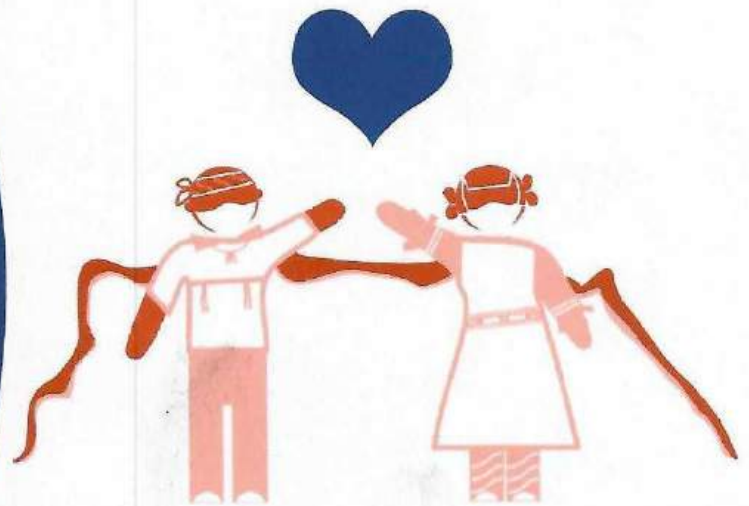

Souder Miller & Associates (SMA) has reviewed the wastewater data received from the Pueblo. They are working on finalizing the design criteria and will then start working with the manufacturer of the treatment system design (Orenco.) They are working with the Pueblo's Realty Office on their Access Permit and then SMA will complete the field survey. Once the survey is completed, SMA will begin working on the production of the construction plans.

Spears Horn Architects has been hired to design new materials, lighting, and office furniture for the Accounting Department at the Tribal Administration Building. Construction Documents were completed in Summer / Fall 2024, and the project is going to be constructed by Missing Link Construction with Office Furniture Systems provided by Creative Interiors. Work is to begin in January 2025.

The project is comprised of new color coordinated Work Stations by Teknion, new Laminate Wood Flooring, new Linear LED lights, new Outlets and Switches, and new Paint. Spears Horn Architects worked closely with Accounting Staff to determine the materials, furniture, and equipment. We are working on upgrading more departments in the Tribal Administration Building.

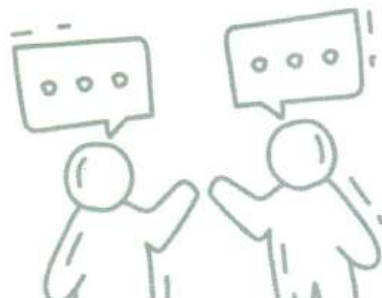

## HOUSING APPLICATIONS

San Ildefonso Tribal Members are encouraged to pick up applications during business hours, Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Applicants can opt for either rental or homeownership. It is crucial to recognize that SIHA aims to increase its current waiting list for grant applications to better document housing needs for Tribal Members. For any questions, please contact Devan Martinez, Housing Manager at the SIHA Office.

## Indian Community Development Black Grant

On December 9, 2024, the San Ildefonso Housing Authority was awarded \$2,000,000 grant to support the purchase of 9 more homes for Deer Tail Phase II and to develop a 10-year Comprehensive Housing Plan by inspecting every home on the Pueblo to document the need for rehabilitation funding. SIHA was the only housing authority in New Mexico to receive this grant. We are excited to end the year on such a positive note.

## Deer Tail Phase II Applicants - HOMEWISE

To initiate the mortgage pre-approval process, Homewise will conduct a hard credit check to analyze the applicant's financial profile. This step marks the beginning of the assessment procedure. While Homewise can also perform a soft credit check it is intended for long-term coaching purposes, allowing Homewise to track progress in debt reduction, monthly payments, spending habits, and credit score improvements. Generally, a hard credit inquiry may lower a credit score by 3-5 points, but most individuals typically recover these points within 30-60 days, or one to two credit cycles. Homewise is currently negotiating with Fannie Mae to enable mortgage pre-approvals via a soft pull, but this initiative is still in progress. Until it is finalized, all new applicants will be subject to a hard credit inquiry, which is standard in the industry.

## Maintenance on Private Homes

Homeowners are responsible for the maintenance of their homes, SIHA may offer assistance for emergency maintenance issues related to health and safety Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Homeowners should be aware that there may be associated costs, as current operating funds are designated specifically for managed units.
